John 13:18-30

Jesus confronting sin is not to bring condemnation but restoration

Who is Jesus to us?

Lord: he to whom a person or thing belongs

The gospel is not about bad people becoming good, but dead people coming to life.

A heart turned towards us

1. Notice Judas' place at the table

2. Notice Jesus' actions towards him

If we submit ourselves to Christ, we walk in the light; if we turn our backs on Him we go into the dark.

John 3:19-20

And the judgment is based on this fact: God's light came into the world, but people loved the darkness more than the light, for their actions were evil. All who do evil hate the light and refuse to go near it for fear their sins will be exposed.

Apprenticeship Prayer Partner Questions:
